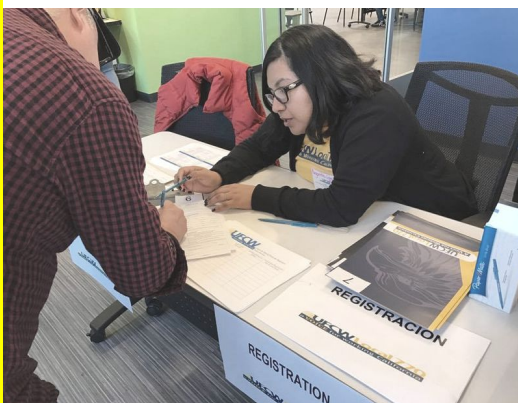

Becoming a Citizen and What to bring to the workshop

What to bring to the workshop:

- Your permanent resident card (Green Card).
- Driver License or any form of ID.
- Social Security Card.
- List of home addresses for the past 5 years and the dates which you lived at that address.
- List of employer names and addresses for the past 5 years and the dates you worked for that employer.
- Dates you have been outside of the U.S for the past 5 years, and the countries you have traveled to. Bring your passport, itineraries, tickets, etc. for all trips made out of the U.S.
- Names, dates of birth, addresses and A#'s (Green Card) for all your children.
- Your most recent tax return.
- A money order for \$ 725.00 payable to "U.S Department of Homeland Security".

If you are applying for citizenship based on marriage, please bring:

- Marriage certificate and / or divorce decrees, if applicable.
- Evidence that your spouse has been a resident for at least 3 years, such as his/her birth certificate, passport, or certificate of naturalization.
- Documents referring to you or your spouse: bank statements, leases, mortgages, IRS tax returns for the last 3 years.
- If you changed your name, the court decree that legally changed your name.

If you think you might be eligible for a fee waiver/ partial fee waiver; please bring your most recent tax returns and proof that you are receiving food stamps, public housing assistance, medical assistance etc.
